"La petite monnaie des jours" Talk with Janine Massard

The Swiss author **Janine Massard** will talk, in French, about her novel "La petite monnaie des jours" at the Alliance Française in Glasgow. Discussion in French and English.

The novel reflects the time in the mid 50's in Switzerland, when the working class started to gain access to some modern conveniences such as cars, household appliances etc. From production to consumerism, the novel explores theses undergoing changes through the eyes of a young girl raised in a poor household. Book available at the AF language office (£5).

Janine Massard was born in Rolle, Switzerland, in 1939. Her novel "La petite monnaie des jours" published in 1985 was really well-received by the critics. She is known for her novels which focus on the working class and the social outcasts in Switzerland.

While in Scotland Janine Massard has been invited by two universities to have a conference-lecture which are open to the public.
